

United Technicians file Opposition briefs to Teamsters and United in Pension lawsuit

June 21, 2019 United Technicians filed opposition briefs in Federal Court against the Teamsters union and United Airlines motions filed in March to dismiss our case.

Read the briefs filed by our United Technicians. The case involves the enforcement of LOA 05-03M that provides to every UAL Technician the RIGHT TO VOTE to choose CARP or a comparable plan in 2010 before the merger with Continental Airlines.

The Teamsters denied that right to United Technicians and we went 6 years without a single increase in pension benefits while the IAM Ramp and Stores Pension went up 53% and the United Airlines Pilots 401k went up 160%.

The Teamsters failed in their #1 Promise to get United Technicians a Pension.

Now our Technicians are fighting the IBT union in Federal Court to enforce LOA 05-03M.

Read <u>LOA 05-03M</u> - negotiated by UAL Technicians in 2005 during 1113 Bankruptcy Negotiations to provide increased pension benefits to every United Technician at United Airlines. **6 Years of additional CARP Pension Benefits that is what it means to you.**

If you were denied the right to file a grievance over this same issue, your rights were likely violated by the Teamsters union and you can help in the fight.
