Pension and Profit Sharing September Update

United Technicians await Judge's decision to move forward in 9th Circuit Court.

United Flight Attendants also file lawsuit over Profit Sharing dilution.

Federal Judge James Donato has not yet ruled on the motions of the defendant Teamsters union and UAL Corporation to dismiss the pension and profit sharing complaint. When news or any information is available we will get that information out to the membership as soon as possible.

Our technicians are fighting for Negotiated Pension improvements we won in 2005, during Bankruptcy. This was language negotiated in the first open negotiations at United Airlines.

Open Negotiations with Professionals In 2005 UAL Technicians signed LOA 05-03M which guaranteed our right to improved Pension Benefits if United Airlines ever established or maintained a Defined Benefit Plan at United Airlines. You can read [LOA 05-03M](#) www.ALTAUnited.com

Profit Sharing is the second part of the United Technicians complaint.
